PARK RULES

Welcome to Pine Point Caravan Park. We hope your stay with us will be an enjoyable. To help make your stay and other visitors/residents stay more enjoyable we ask you to comply with the following conditions:

<u>VEHICLES</u> The speed limit for any vehicle is walking pace only to a maximum of 5kmph. Only paying guests vehicles may

enter the park.

VISITORS Your visitors are your responsibility. Please ensure they adhere to the park rules. Visitor's cars can be left in

adjacent car park. Visitors staying overnight will be allowed at the discretion of park management, and will be charged a nominal fee. Only visitors staying overnight and paying a fee are entitled to use showers. Other

visitors are required to leave the park by 10pm.

PETS Pets are not permitted in rental caravans.

Pets are allowed, under strict control when using your own van/tent. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs must not be left unattended in the park. Dogs must not disturb other patrons. Owners are asked to clean up after their pets immediately. FAILURE TO COMPLY with these rules will result in eviction from the park.

SITES To ensure the comfort of everyone in the park we limit the number of persons on a site to 6. We allow one

caravan and annex or one tent and vehicle. Check-out is 11am

<u>RENTAL CARAVANS</u> Numbers accommodated in a van may not exceed the number of beds provided. All vans are non-smoking.

Check-out 11am (Smoking areas are provided outdoor area only)

FIRE REGULATIONS Campfires are not permitted on any sites. Only main campfire lit when manager present & weather

permitting. Pot Belly in Rookery area to be used other times. For safety reasons, drawbars for vans must face the roadway.

<u>SMOKING</u> The Park has a non-smoking policy in all shared areas. This includes rental vans, camp kitchen, barbecue area,

playgrounds, games room & amenities block etc. Smokers are asked to respect other guests when smoking.

<u>RUBBISH</u> Please help keep our park looking good by keeping your site /accommodation tidy.

Please care for the environment by placing paper, cardboard, in the recycling bins (Yellow lid) at our bin areas. 10c Cans & bottles to be placed in red crates & wrap all household, fish offal, and disposable nappies and place in rubbish bins

provided.

<u>CONDUCT</u> To ensure the enjoyment of all guests, guests are requested to restrain from using any type of loud or offensive

behaviour. Noise is to be kept to a minimum. Please make no noise between 11pm and 7am. If you have any

problems with the conduct of other guests please contact the management.

<u>CHILDREN</u> Your children, and those in your care, must be supervised by parents / adults at all times, and in all areas of the park, including playground and amenities block. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult when using park facilities.

BIKES ETC Helmets must be worn when riding bicycles, skate boards, roller blades etc. All road rules apply in the park.

For safety reasons no bicycles, skate boards etc are to be used after sunset.

ANNEXES To minimise damage to the grass, floors are not permitted in annexes.

CAR/BOAT WASH

Car and boat washing is not permitted in the park. Washing facilities are provided outside the main gate.

BBQ's Please leave barbecues in clean condition after use.

ROOKERY

Please place all rubbish in bins provided and leave area in clean condition after use. Wipe down sink/bench

tables etc. Please remember this is a shared area for all so please pack away your things.

COMPLIANCE

In the interest of all guests, failure to comply with the park rules may result in eviction from the park.

Management reserves the right to cancel any booking at any time.

PAYMENT All payments for accommodation and or site fees are payable in advance. Sorry, if you leave early, you will not

be entitled to a refund.
